Strengthening Technology Transfer Ecosystem through Innovative and Digital Approaches

The STEIDA Project aims to enhance the technology transfer (TT) ecosystem by fostering national and international collaboration among higher education institutions (HEIs), academics, businesses, students, entrepreneurs, and other stakeholders. By developing and utilising digital platforms and networks, the project seeks to bridge the gap between academia and industry, equipping students with new competencies. The project will involve sharing best practices, developing training modules, and creating a digital collaboration platform. Expected outcomes include comprehensive studies, an ECTS-compatible curriculum, and new international collaborations facilitated through the digital platform.

STEIDA is funded by the European Commission under the Erasmus+ programme.

Specific objectives

- Conduct comprehensive TT ecosystem studies and reveal best practices of HEIs and other actors of the TT ecosystem to develop and strengthen knowledge and TT with innovative methods
- Increase capacity of higher education and other stakeholders in the ecosystem for knowledge and technical training through the development and implementation of new curricula
- Facilitate national and international cooperation among HEIs, academics, businesses, students, entrepreneurs and other stakeholders through the development/utilisation of digital platforms and networks
- Bridge the gap between academia and industry by providing students with new competencies

Key outcomes

- Strengthened national and international networks between academia, industry, and other stakeholders, fostering ongoing innovation and TT
- Development of an ECTS-compatible curriculum and capacity-building modules, leading to enhanced competencies of students and staff in TT
- Long-term, productive collaborations between HEIs and industry, resulting in increased commercialisation of research and practical application of innovations
- Contributed to economic growth and job creation through the successful transfer and commercialisation of technologies
